SUPPORT PRIMARY LAW.

IT IS SIGNIFICANT that just at this time, when the old Republican machine is attempting to hoodwink the rank and file of the Republicans of Oregon to repudiate the direct primary law, New York State Republicans are making an effort to enact such legislation.

A press dispatch from Albany, N. Y., recently is as follows:

"The Legislature, in special session, is in receipt of a message from Governor Hughes, urging the enactment of a direct primary law. That portion of the message reads as follows:

"I recommend for your consideration the amendment of the law relating to primaries, the making of suitable provision for direct nomination of candidates for public office and in connection therewith provisions for representative and responsible party management.

"The people are dissatisfied with present conditions, and demand a change. Whatever may be said of the imperfections in the laws relating to this matter in other jurisdictions, there can be no question that these laws reflect a wholesome sentiment, which is countrywide and cannot be denied."
