Every useful invention, designed to work economy in the cost of production has had the same reception. The spinning jenny caused riots, the linotype strikes, and so on down the list.

The pages of history are filled with opposition to progress. Occasionally, in the life of nations, the conservative triumphs and fastens the existing conditions as the irrevocable law of the land. Then progress ends—as in India and China.

It is this conservatism, born of ignorance due to isolation, and commonly called mossbackism in Oregon, this resistance to progress, that has retarded the growth and development of the State.

The conflict between progression and retrogression exists everywhere. Even here in Marshfield innovations and attempts at progress like paving and sewers have been resisted. In every instance, however, the people have proven themselves to be progressive and the march has been ever onward with only temporary halts. If a community is worth fighting for the progressives are bound to win. If it is not, the place is abandoned to its lethargy by the red-blooded and left to peacefully vegetate.

Coos Bay cannot afford to block progress by opposition to the harbor improvement. If it were not for the government dredge last year the steamer Narn Smith could not now make its trip from the slip of the C. A. Smith mill with its present tonnage. If active steps are not taken to protect, preserve and develop this great natural harbor the people are flying in the face of Providence and progress.

If the blessings that invest Coos Bay are worth saving and using and expanding, there must be a knowledgeable merging of the common interests here that will compel results of the biggest and richest sort. We can no longer afford to fritter away the time in fighting and indulge selfish concerns to the defeating of the best interests of the entire section. IT MUST BE "COOS BAY FOR ALL AND ALL FOR COOS BAY," from this day henceforth. That is all we need; the rest will come easy.
