That is the slogan of the progressive movement among the Republicans of Ohio. It was spoken by James R. Garfield in his address to a great audience at Cleveland the other night and it was greeted with resounding cheers.

It is a slogan that fits the times. Unmistakably society is getting away from its long undue reverence for property interests and putting foremost the interests of manhood. Its governments are giving more thought

to human rights and less to property rights; statute books which have been devoted chiefly to laws for the protection of property, are giving larger place to laws for the protection of men. The slogan is a sign of the progress of the world and its advancement to better things.

There are numerous evidences of a strong progressive movement in Ohio, even though the political machinery of the State is in the hands of men who have left nothing undone to suppress it. Garfield had an enthusiastic demonstration at Cleveland and he has promise of support everywhere in his fight. The other day the city of Urbana sent word to Uncle Joe Cannon that he needn't come and make his Chautauqua address, because he had threatened that he would "jump all over" the progressive leaders of Ohio.
