IT DOESN'T FOOL ANY ONE.

A FOOL argument for the assembly is that the constitution guarantees a peaceable assembly. It is all right for voters to assemble all they please to talk matters over; but the laws of the State of Oregon provide for the nomination of men for office in a certain way, and that way should be followed as long as the law prevails. The attempt to use the assembly for making nominations is a subversion of the law and it is childish and silly to ring in the constitution, which referred to an entirely different thing; but it is a sample of the ways of the assembly people.

Fortunately the public understands all this and is not being fooled at all by such talk. But wait and let the voters themselves speak when they go into the primaries. The assembly nominees all over the State will feel a rap that will make them squirm.

MILLIONS ANNIHILATED BY FOREST FIRES.

FIRE IS A GOOD SERVANT, but a bad master.

The forest fire illuminates the platitude with terrible light.

For three months already the lurid flames of burning forests, farms and homes destroyed, human beings and animals cremated alive, the soil itself consumed in places and wealth to the amount of millions annihilated, have darkened the timber lands of the country.

If any argument were needed in behalf of conservation of natural resources, it would be supplied by the appalling losses caused by these fires. They also form an additional proof of the value of the federal forest service and of national conservation, for the mischief is not confined to the limits of a State or of several States, but affects the resources and waterpower of the whole nation.

The drought renders it incumbent

on every one to exercise especial care when in the woods. The smoker should consider himself under special obligation not to let a single spark of living flame fall to the ground. The cigar, the pipe, the cigarette should all be dead before they are thrown away or emptied. The camper should soak the soil around his fire, as well as the fire itself with water. One spark, one dry leaf or twig and one breath of air to fan the tiny flame are all that are needed these days to start a forest fire.

Make it a matter of personal pride no less than of civic responsibility to be a fire warden unofficially, and to prevent this needless destruction of private property and public resources.
