CANNON CANNOT STOP THIS RACKET.

"MAY GOD send men into public life, honest and courageous, to stop this racket."

The author of this pious prayer is none other than the Hon. Joseph Gurney Cannon. The "racket" to which he refers is the people's protest against corruption in politics and against privilege for private individuals or corporations at the expense of the public. Providential men have been sent to the Legislature, to the Governorships, to Congress to voice the protest and right the wrong, but to Mr. Cannon they look like demagogues.

It is all sad and all funny. It shows that it makes a difference whose ox is gored. If the "demagogues" upheld Cannon, to him they would seem patriots. It demonstrates that Mr. Cannon is as blind to the meaning of the new politics, to the goals and character of its representative men, as a bat to the sunshine.

Mr. Cannon's misunderstanding of the progressive movement, though inborn and ineradicable, is not peculiar to himself. It is common to the entire class to which he belongs—men to whom politics is a business and therefore to be pursued to private advantage.

His position and views are repudiated by men who are not considered progressive Republicans. Representative Longworth, for example, announces that Mr. Cannon cannot be elected Speaker again and that he (Mr. Longworth) will never again vote for him. As Mr. Longworth is close to the Taft administration, his announcement involves its repudiation of Mr. Cannon.
