PROSPECTS OF THE POSTAL BANKS.

HAVING succeeded in putting through a postal savings bank law, the administration is now determined, so we are informed, to permit no unnecessary delay in the matter of putting the postal savings banks into actual operation.

The machinery necessary to the expeditious establishment of the system is now being planned. Once a satisfactory model has been devised and accepted the work of installation can be carried on with rapidity.

But it will require a year or two to put the banks into operation throughout the entire country. Much will depend, however, upon the plan followed.

The interest which the public everywhere is manifesting in the matter, and the apparent disposition of private banking institutions to view the innovation with more friendly eyes, taken in connection with the administration's announced determination to press their organization and opening, combine to make the prospects for the postal savings banks very satisfactory.
