PROSPECTS OF THE POSTAL BANKS.

AVING succeeded in putting through a postal savings bank law, the administration is now determined, so we are informed, to permit no unnecessary delay in the rantter of putting the postal savings banks into actual operation. There have been rumors to the effect that organization under the law would be delayed, that little would be done in the way of establishing the banks this year, that even when undertaken the work of inaugurating the system would be carried on only in a halfhearted fashion. All this appears to will be sold at a very low price to have been entirely baseless. The make room for a new shipment that postal bank system will be put into is due. Come in and see them; the actual operation at many points next price will surprise you, fall and it will be extended as rapidly as the interests of a safe and sound organization will permit.

The machinery necessary to the satisfactory model has been devised ate. and accepted the work of installation can be carried on with rapidity. The great need at the beginning, next to a satisfactory model, will be a corps of trained organizers and instructors whose duty it will be to see to the starting of the machinery in the different communities. One great advantage which the government enjoys in this connection is its ability to call upon workers in the postal money order and registry departments who are already trained in the handling of money and who are qualified to fill responsible positions in the postal banks.

But it will require a year or two to put the banks into operation throughout the entire country. Much will depend, however, apon the plan followed. If the smaller communities , shall be provided with banks before an attempt shall be made to establish them in the sub-stations of the larger ones,2 the system may be extended more rapidly. It is quite probable that all sub-stations of consequence will have postal savings bank departments in time, but this must be a matter of natural and not of forced growth.

The interest which the public everywhere is manifesting in the matter, and the apparent disposition of private banking institutions to view the innovation with more friendly eyes, taken in connection with the administration's announced determination to press their organization and opening, combine to make the prosvery satisfactory.—Christian Science a trial order and see, Monitor,
