CRAWFORD IS SENTENCED.

Marshfield Lawyer Goes to Jail For Impersonating Secret Service Man. PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 14 .- J. C. Crawford, the automobile sleuth of Marshfield, appeared in the United States Court and pleaded guilty to the charge of impersonating a Secret Service officer of the United States
