

TWO NEW ARTISTIC PATTERNS FOR GUSHION AND GENTERPIECE

The St. Malo design is carried out on a groundwork of gray linen. The colors of the pattern are pinks, greens and browns of various shades. Tans. browns and greens are another good color scheme, or for drawing rooms more delicate tints may be employed. The effect is artistic in any case if the work is carefully and well done.
