#### DOCTORS BOOST PRICES.

High Cost of Living Given as Reason at Mason City.

MASON CITY, Ia., Nov. 23.—The high cost of living is given by the county medical association for the raise in the schedule of charges for professional services. An agreement has been reached which is signed by nearly every physician in the county. The boost means that day calls are raised to \$1.50 and night calls from \$1.50 to \$3.

Country calls are \$3 for the first mile and 50 cents per mile thereafter. Night country calls will be 75 cents for each additional mile traveled after the first mile. All obstetric cases are boosted from \$10 to \$15.

Washington Woman Who Killed Boy Convicted of Murder.

WENATCHEE, Wash., Nov. 23.—The jury in the case of Mrs. Totten after being out all night returned a verdict of murder in the first degree for killing James Sutton last August. The boy was cutting a wire fence erected by Mrs. Totten across an undedicated road on her property when she shot him dead. Mrs. Beebe, mother of Mrs. Totten who was also indicted will be tried next week.
