BIG STEAMER IS STRANDED

British Coal Carrier Goes Ashore With 50 Men On Virginia Coast.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Mar. 16.—Fifty men are in peril on the stranded British steamer Manchuria on the Virginia coast, thirty miles south of Cape Henry. A furious storm is raging. The life-saving crew is endeavoring to aid the men. The vessel is in a perilous position.

The Manchuria was bound from Newport News for Tampico, Mexico, with coal.

Later the gale so moderated that it is believed the men on the Manchuria are now out of danger.

Mahan threatened to kill him. Mr. Brown refused to discuss this matter today at any place except the inquest, but stated that he had advised McClallen to "let the woman alone."

Woman Gives Version.

That Mahan threatened to kill McClallen because he kept company with Miss Spelcher was the testimony of the woman before the coroner's jury. Incidental to her evidence, District Attorney Brown read two letters written by Mahan to Miss Spelcher in which Mahan declared his love for the woman and referred to McClallen in base terms. Most important, however, of all points brought out while Miss Spelcher was on the witness stand was that Mahan, himself, ushered in the tragedy by moving his right hand toward his hip pocket as if to draw the pistol resting there, after McClallen had warned him not to advance further.

Replying to a point-blank question put by Brown, Miss Spelcher denied that she and Mahan were ever engaged to be married. "I quit Mahan's employ last November," said the witness, "when he returned from Portland and accused me of wrong doing. Then he threatened to kill McClallen if I kept company with him. I immediately notified Mr. McClallen by note of his danger, and Mr. McClallen, after that, carried a pistol when we were together."

Says Mahan Made First Move.

Bringing her story to bear directly on the shooting, Miss Spelcher gave testimony decidedly favorable to McClallen. After reciting the visit to the theatre with McClallen, she said that while she was on her way home with him that Mahan stepped in front of them at the place where the killing occurred.

"Mahan advanced toward us and placed his right hand on his hip pocket, at the same time muttering something that I did not understand," said Miss Spelcher. "Mr. McClallen pushed me to one side and said to Mahan 'stop, don't come a step further.' Mahan did not stop and Mr. McClallen fired at him. At the first shot I hurried down the street, dazed, and saw no more."

Expect That Mines In British Columbia Will Close Down Soon.

Negotiations for the renewal of the working agreement signed two years ago so far have been fruitless. The agreement expires April 1. The union men insist on a "closed shop" and a concession in wages.
