Discussing the subject of location, the commission says in its report:

These difficulties are due chiefly to the fact that in most cases the monument is not designed for a specific site...

It is self evident that the character of the monument should determine the nature of its setting.

That so many monuments stand in unfortunate places is due not to carelessness or lack of deliberation, but to the failure to recognize the fact that a well placed monument forms an integral part of its surroundings.
