STRICKEN ILL ON WAY HERE

Local Man Receives News of Sudden Illness of Aged Father.

George G. Capps, foreman of The Times' composing room and a resident of this city since 1890, last Christmas, received the distressing news by telegraph this morning that his father, an octogenarian, became seriously ill in Portland yesterday.

The elder Mr. Capps is on his way from the east to visit his son here. The meeting between the two, which was to have taken place here upon the arrival of the steamer Breakwater on her next incoming trip, was to have been the first meeting between father and son to have taken place for eleven years.

Despite the almost impassable condition of the roads between here and Roseburg, the younger Mr. Capps will leave here tomorrow morning in an automobile in an effort to make railroad connections at Roseburg which will enable him to reach his father's bedside tomorrow night.

BAND STAND READY.

Contractor Completes Open Air Stand at Foot of Commercial

The band stand at the foot of Commercial street erected by the Fourth of July committee of the Chamber of Commerce for use during the celebration on July 3rd and 4th, was completed by Contractor Corthell at noon today and is now ready for the tri-color decorations of bunting and flags.

The stand, which is 16 feet wide by 24 feet in length, will easily accommodate the thirty-six piece band which has been engaged by the committee to provide the music at the open air concerts.

CIVIL WAR IN STATE MILITIA

DEPOSED CAPTAIN SHEPHERD SAYS HE WILL TAKE COMMAND OF CRUISER BOSTON BY FORCE OF ARMS IF NEED BE.

"I shall take command of the United States cruiser Boston either by force of arms or by injunction," declared Captain George Shepherd, deposed captain of the vessel, recently.

Shepherd explained that he had just received an opinion from Attorney-General Crawford, who holds that Adjutant-General Finzer, of the Oregon State Militia, had nothing to do with the Oregon Naval Reserve up to May 20, and, therefore, the acts of the court of inquiry which he conducted, resulting in the removal of Shepherd as captain of the organization, are void. Captain Shepherd says he had been waiting for an opinion in this case for several weeks, and as it is favorable to him he declares he will take steps immediately to assume what he regards as his rightful position as captain of the Boston.

John McNulty, an officer in the reserve, was removed at the same time at the conclusion of the court of inquiry. Captain John Blain was permitted to resign instead of suffering removal. Previous to the investigation there had been bad feeling among various officers of the reserve over the matter of who should have charge of the cruiser. It finally terminated in a mixup at a drill in the Armory, when Blain and George H. Wischussen, the sergeant-at-arms, exchanged blows after Wischussen had been ordered by Shepherd to escort Blain out of the building.

It appears that the trouble first arose over the fact that Shepherd does not hold a master's papers, and it was contended that he was ineligible to be captain of the Boston.

"But it is not necessary for me to hold master's papers," said Shepherd. "I also have gone to the trouble to find out definitely about this phase of the subject. I have received an answer to a letter I wrote the Navy Department, telling me that it would not be necessary for me to hold a master's license in order to be Captain of the Boston. I was informed that such a qualification is not imper-

ative to entitle one to be Captain of a cruiser like the Boston, which has been loaned to a state organization. The report to the contrary originated wholly in Portland."

After the ousting from the court of inquiry, Captain J. Speler, the harbor-master, and a lieutenant-commander, was delegated to bring the Boston from Bremerton to Portland. After her arrival this week Captain John J. Reynolds was elected captain of the Boston. It was given out that he would take charge of the cruiser as soon as he received his commission from Governor West. The governor paid an official visit to the Boston, and Reynolds has been given his commission.—Portland Telegram.
