MOTHER KEEPS HER HUSKY SONS IN BED FOR YEARS

GLOVERVILLE, N. Y., Sept. 21.—Although reputable physicians, humane officers, and many other have examined the three stalwart sons of Mr. and Mrs. John Bennett of the town of Hope, Hamilton county, and found nothing the matter with them, the three men have been confined to their beds for a period of from six to ten years.

They were placed in this peculiar plight by the hypnotic influence of their mother, who has told them they are suffering from heart disease. George, aged 32 years, has been confined to his bed for the last eight years; Ward, aged 28, has been in bed for the last ten years, and Frank aged 27 years, has not been out of bed for a period of approximately six years.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Bennett insist the men are suffering terribly and both scoff at the idea that they have been hypnotized. The town of Hope has offered to have the men sent to a hospital for treatment, but the parents will not allow it. Hundreds have been interested in the strange case and have visited the home, but no one has been able to fathom it. The Bennetts own a good sized farm which yields them a comfortable living. Mr. Bennett, who seems to be a man of considerable intelligence, does the farming and his wife devotes most of her time in caring for the three "invalids."

The three men are fine types of manhood. They are all six footers and although pale as a result of their long confinement, are still hardy, robust men, able to get out and do a big day's work.

Physicians were at first mystified over the strange case, but there is not one of the many who have examined the men but who expresses the same opinion, that the men are as sound as a dollar.

SOUGHT FOR CRIME.

Former Lady Barber of Bandon Is Accused at Roseburg.

ROSEBURG, Ore., Sept. 21.—Clara May Montgomery, the female tonorial artist, who first came into prominence in Roseburg about six months ago when she caused the arrest of Carl Busch, the German wrestler, on a statutory charge, is again before the public eye, and in the event of apprehension will probably be compelled to face the courts and explain her conduct.

Mrs. Montgomery about two months ago, suddenly left Roseburg and went to Bandon. At the time of her disappearance, she not only left a deficit in her accounts, but with the nerve of a "Jobe," transported the furniture of the shop over the mountains and into Coos county. Inasmuch as she had failed to pay for the furniture, the owner became somewhat worried, and after repeated threats, persuaded her to remit the amount of the unbalanced account in full.

Business in Bandon failed to materialize as she had anticipated, and about two weeks ago the "fair" lady returned to Roseburg. Practically without funds, she appealed to a number of her former customers for assistance, among them being I. L. Dompier, a half-breed Indian who is well-known in police circles in this city.

After days of planning, the couple finally visited Sam Smith's livery barn, at the corner of Rose and Oak streets, and after relating a feasible tale, hired two saddle horses with which to enjoy a brief ride. Leaving the stables on Monday, September 11, the couple proceeded south and not until Friday was Mr. Smith able to ascertain the whereabouts of the fleeing couple. In Friday's mail there came a letter, bearing an Ashland date, in which it was stated that the horses were at that city and could be recovered by the owner in the event he saw fit to come to Ashland and prove their identity.

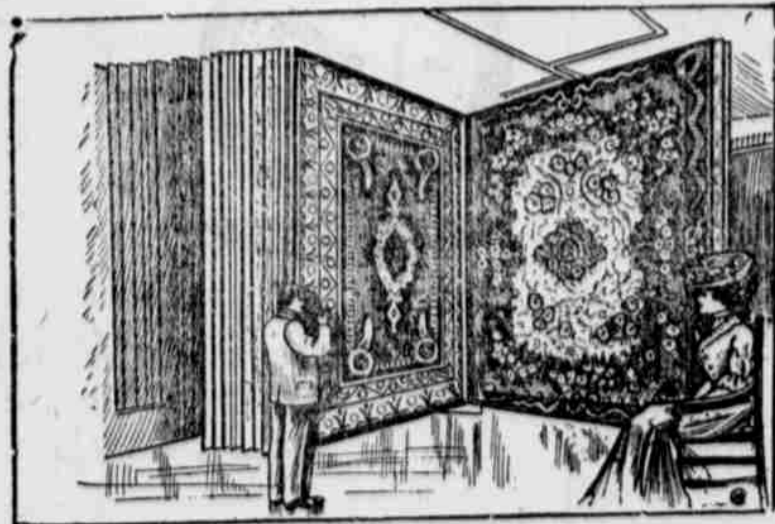
