The Dairymen's meeting held in Port Orford last Saturday, was quite interesting, because it indicated that the proposition of starting a Cheese Factory at Elk River would result in success. The reports of Messrs. Barrett and Zumwalt showed that 145 cows had been subscribed, and that each subscribed would have more than they promised, and that at least 200 cows could be had under favorable conditions.
