BLAMES THE

When a prominent grocer was interviewed as to the reasons for the continued rise in the price of coffee, he replied by saying that it all hinged on the doings of the Arbuckle company, which seems to be in reality the coffee trust.

"Some time ago the Arbuckle people made it possible for the Brazilian government to borrow about \$75,-000,000. French Observer Considers Slumber

French observers, MM. Legendre and poisoning of the brain, has, according to a scientific contemporary, been the frontal lobe of the brain. And The poison of sleep, in fact, is believed to be an antidote for all the poisonous by-products produced in the human

The experiment which is described as having led to the above extraordinary theory was as follows: Serum from the brain of a dog, which had died of insomnia, was injected into another dog. It fell into a deep sleep, from which it awoke in a perfectly healthy state. The in-ference that sleep is due to a natural poison in the brain, however, scarcely seems to follow as a logical conclusion.
