Intelligence presented by the co-operative societies shows that even where there has been an advance in wages the percentage has not kept pace with the rise in the cost of food supplies. The president says that the information collected by the Department of State is a permanent contribution to the history of the efforts of producers and consumers to solve for themselves the economic problems of production, distribution, and consumption. If the co-operative associations which have been in existence for half a century have not been able to determine the fundamental causes of the increased cost of living or to retard the advance, the student of social progress may at least derive instruction from the account of the associations and their influence on the wellbeing of their members.

The president also calls attention to his message of February 2, in which he recommended an international commission to look into the cause for the high prices of the necessities of life and the possible remedies. Should such a commission be authorized by congress, he says, the relation of the co-operative societies to this subject would be of great interest.






