Bay Times) NEW YORK, Oct. 12.—The flow-er of the United States navy lies at anchor on the Hudson river to-day, an armada whose like has never been assembled in the West-ern world before. For 15 miles— from the armored cruiser Tennessee off Thirtieth street, to the Ajax, last of the fuel ships, far north of Spuyten Duyvil Creek—it lies in a double line. The stragglers ar-rived tonight. Perhaps never again will such an aggregation of sea fighters be assembled. Some naval 16 authorities predict that the limit of 10 big battleships construction is fast being reached. A few years hence may find the navies of the world relying on smaller ships in greater numbers.


