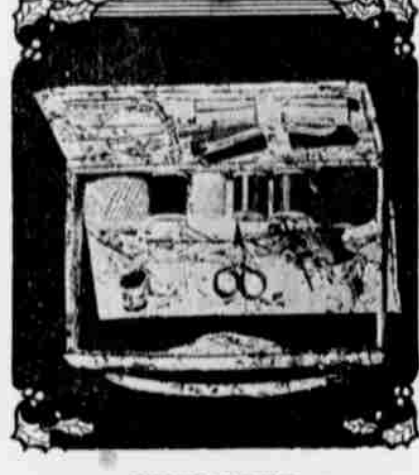

PLAN IS TO BLOCK HILL

Harriman Interests Rush Up McKenzie Valley.

EUGENE, Or., Dec. 4.—Interests of the Harriman interests to force the Hill people in the building of a railroad up the McKenzie Valley, evidenced by the copy of a resolution of the board of directors of the Oregon & California Railroad Company filed with the secretary of state with the Lane County Clerk.

This resolution authorizes the construction of a trifle over 24 mile railroad from a point on the Nat'l Klamath cut-off, a few miles east of Springfield, up the McKenzie Valley to Martin's Rapids, where the Oregon Power Company is doing the preliminary work on a hydro-electric project.

The action of the Harriman interests came rather as a surprise, as it was definitely known that the land, Eugene & Eastern survey had been at work all summer closing up on old surveys when Al W. first planned the Portland, Eugene & Eastern system, and it had been understood that an electric line to be built. In fact President S. Horn of the Portland, Eugene & Eastern, has made announcements that his company was considering building of this line, but at that time had no definite news to give out.

The Oregon Electric, since it had acquired water power rights at Lake, capable of developing 11 horsepower, was also popularly supposed to be planning the construction of a railroad up the McKenzie and thence to the junction with Oregon Trunk east of the Three Tiers.

HONOR MRS. DUNIWAY

Oregon Suffragist Gets Victory over Long Struggle.

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 4.—Gail Scott Duniway, done in her year.

Below the name of Governor Wald West upon the proclamation that makes equal suffrage effective Oregon, the counter-signature of Duniway, written by her sister, was her final word in a campaign that has been carried on by her dominantly for more than 41 years. "There, she said, as she laid the pen and the Governor bent her shoulder to place the blotter on the signature; "It's a fact last."

The proclamation was written Mrs. Duniway herself at Governor West's suggestion and, with the caption of his signature and the testing signature of Secretary State Olcott, every line upon parchment was made by her pen. West had her fill out the blank numbers and dates, so the clamor might uniformly be representative of her work.

BARNARD'S PARTNER DEAD

The Roseburg Review says: "C. P. Barnard, of the Roseburg stage line, has received a message to the effect that his partner, Eli Bangs, of Eugene, died very suddenly. Mr. Bangs, tired in apparently good health according to the message, but died after without a struggle. Mr. Bangs was one of the best known men in Eugene and has a host of friends who regret to learn of his death. Mr. Barnard will probably attend a funeral which will be held at Eugene."
