The Port Orford Tribune publishes
the following:

The greatest development opera-
tions ever begun in Curry county
are now fairly under way at
Chetco, where the Brookings Box
and Lumber Co. are making prepara-
tions to cut and ship their
timber that is located in this coun-
ty.

The company owns 35,000 acres
of the finest timber in this part
of the state, and they estimate that
it will take close to 30 years to
cut and market the lumber. And
another thing that makes the fu-
ture look rosy for Chetco is that
the Owen Bros, who own something
like a similar amount of redwood
in Del Norte county, contemplate
shipping their lumber from the
same port.

The Brookings people are laying
out their townsite, location for the
mills, etc., about a mile north of
the mouth of the Chetco river, and
surrounding the outside harbor
from which they will do their
shipping. The harbor is a small
bay within a large one, and is
well protected from everything but
southwest storms, and it is esti-
mated that a short seawall, upon
which the company is figuring and
expects to build at a cost of \$150,-
000 or \$200,000, will give it am-
ple protection from this direction.
A short wharf will extend into
thirty feet of water, with fifty
feet not far away, and for an open
harbor it is second only to Port
Orford.

The company is working 20 or
25 men at present, but this num-
ber will be gradually augmented
until summer fully opens, when
they will have 400 on the pay
roll. A mill cutting 50,000 feet
per day will be in operation be-
fore the first of May, and from
this mill the lumber for the town
and the timbers for railroads and
their big mill will be cut. The
latter mill when completed, which
will probably be nearly two years
hence, will be one of the most
modern in existence and will cut
250,000 feet per day. It will also
be built at the townsite, and rail-
roads run into the woods to convey
the logs to it. Chetco river will
be dammed and the power used
for various purposes, besides the
pond thus formed will be used for
booming logs. A railroad is now
being built to this site that will
supply the mills with logs for many
years to come.

A petition has been circulated
asking for a postoffice at Brook-
ings, which is soon to be the larg-
est town in Curry county. It is
not a wildcat or stock selling
scheme, such as given this county
so many black eyes in the past,
but it is a strictly business prop-
osition, backed by business men
with unlimited means at their
command. It marks the beginning
of a new era for northern Curry.

DAYS WILL BE
LONGER NOW

Yesterday was One of the
Shortest in the Year—
Cold Weather.

Yesterday was one of the shortest
days of the year. It is a mooted
question whether the 21st or 22nd of
December is the shortest, there be-
ing very little difference, if any.

So far as the government records
go, the three days, December 20, 21,
22, are of equal length. The sun rose
Saturday morning at 7:50 a. m., and
set at 4:28 p. m., a bare eight hours
and 38 minutes of shining, a long
15 hours and 24 minutes of absence.
Sunday the sun rose one minute
later, also set one minute later,
which latter time indicates that dur-
ing the day Mother Earth on her axis
turned the equator just far enough
south to make one minute's differ-
ence in the time of the sun's setting.
