Captain Bartlett said an aeroplane could be taken by land to Cape Morris K. Jessup, which is 381 miles from the pole. With the latest machine this would mean only a four hours' flight to the pole, he said. The ice would furnish suitable landing places all along the route, but all necessary supplies would have to be carried to and from the pole.

"The ideal tril," said the speaker, "would be to go from Cape Jesaup directly over to the pole and land at Cape Chelluskin in Siberia, the latter point, however, being 720 miles beyond the pole. In July and August the conditions are perfect for flying and I can see no serious difficulties which might not be guarded against."
