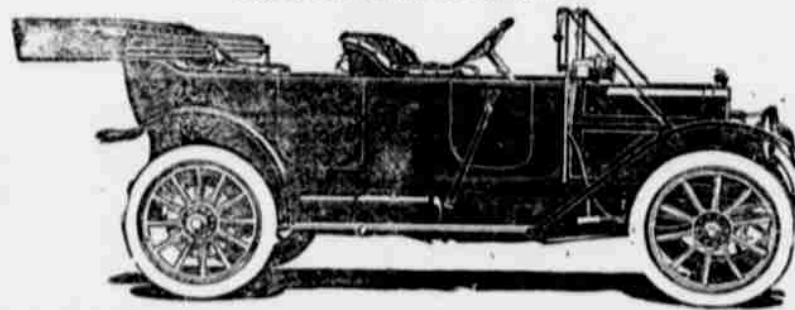

NEW USE FOR AEROPLANES

CHRISTOFFERSON JOINS HUNT FOR ESCAPED CONVICT IN CALIFORNIA WITH HIS HYDROPLANE—FOG STOPS PURSUIT.

Monday's San Francisco Call says "The Marin County manhunt, with Herbert Repsold, the escaped San Quentin 'perfumed burglar' convict as the quarry, was continued without success all day and all night by 100 armed men, some of them possessing authority, but the majority worried ranchmen, anxious for the safety of their women folks. "The chase was not confined to the land, however, for the Call conducted a keen and novel search along the Marin County bay shore line by means of the hydro-plane of Christofferson. With a reporter of the Call as a passenger and guard, the aviator skimmed in and out of the indentations of the irregular shore line in the afternoon until a dense fog compelled a return to the beach near the United States army transport docks."

BIG MEN TO DUEL.

Noted French Politicians May Cross Swords.

(By Associated Press to Coos Bay Times.) VERSAILLES, France, Jan. 17.—Premier Raymond Poincaré was at the opening today of the National Congress for the election of a president. Poincaré at once appointed Aristide Briand, minister of Justice, and L. Klotz, minister of finance, to act as his seconds to arrange a duel. The incident between Poincaré and Clemenceau arose out of a letter sent by the former premier to Poincaré, which was considered offensive by Poincaré. The premier promptly sent two seconds to ask for an explanation and unless this should prove satisfactory under the customs of France, the incident will result in a duel.

Premier Raymond Poincaré received 381 votes and Jules Pams 333 votes on the first ballot for the election of president of the republic. Another ballot will thus be necessary as neither obtained a majority of the total vote.
