

CITY MORALS TALKED OVER

Ministers and Councilmen Decide That Men Involved in Vice Are Culpable.

That the men associating with the women of ill repute are largely to blame for the alleged immoral conditions in Marshfield and are the ones to be punished and driven out of the community was the conclusion reached yesterday afternoon at a conference of the Marshfield ministers and the special committee of the Marshfield City Council. Hitherto the scarlet women have been prosecuted and their male paramours left alone. The conference was private and while the question was discussed at length, the parties present do not feel that it would be best to give out the full plans of the campaign agreed upon.

It is stated that the conference was most harmonious, that the ministers were not radical but merely anxious for the welfare of the community to cleanse it morally. They pointed out that it was especially essential for the boys and girls that the moral standard be raised.

It is understood that the Councilmen expressed the same view and also that it would be beneficial to the older residents to have the standard raised.

The Marshfield officials will probably endeavor to handle the situation themselves for the time being, but if they find themselves unable to cope with the situation then Prosecutor Liljeqvist and other authorities may be appealed to. At any rate, the joint committee of ministers and city officials will co-operate with Prosecutor Liljeqvist in any crusade that he may launch along this line.

It is likely that the undesirable will soon be lined up and by fines and other punishment meted out by Recorder Butler will be made to mend their ways or leave the community. Some of the worst offenders are said to have jobs and some are said to be running places of business, but these will go the same as the rest.

The crusade will probably be made all the way along the line and parties co-operating or purposely ignoring vice around their places will be made to suffer for it.
