HENRY SENGSTACKEN

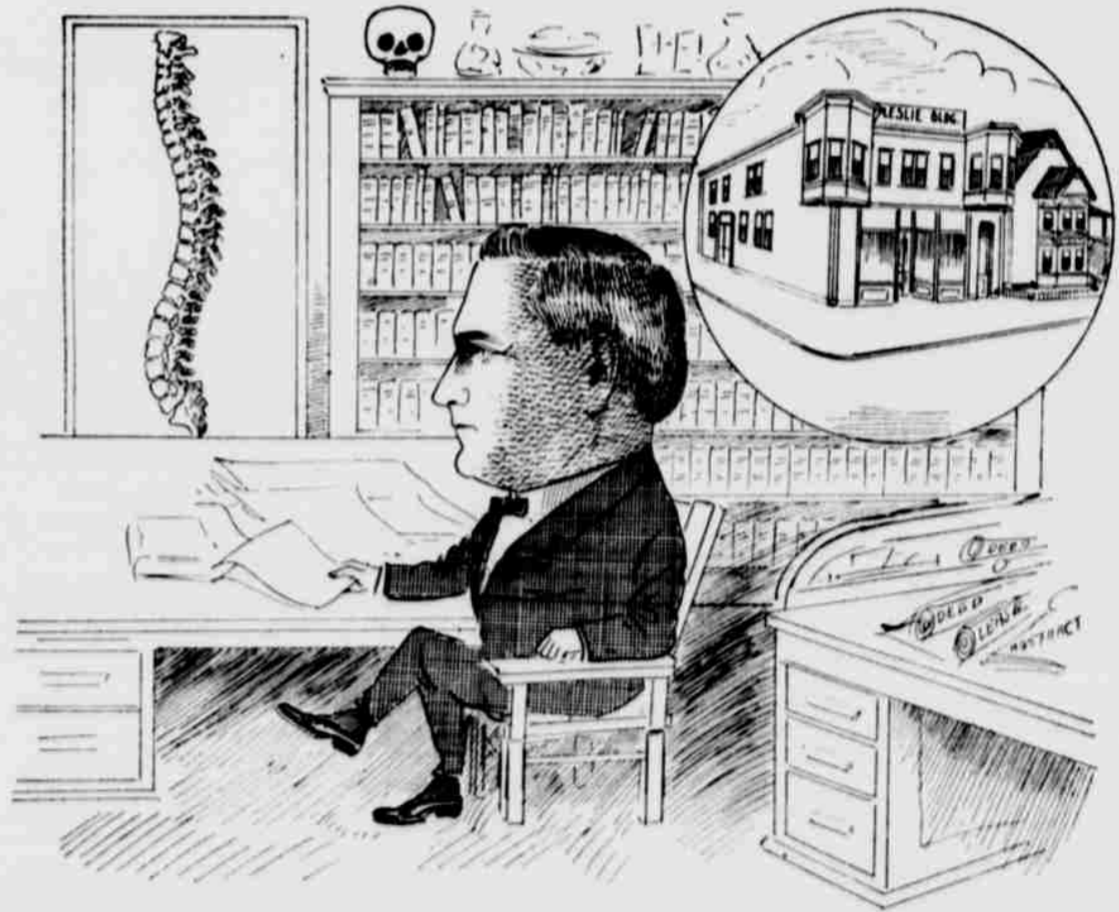
