When Ford fitted to the other. production ran up into the hundreds of motor cars per day it was ob-viously impossible to test in this way, as cylinders were bored in one portion of the plant, while the pistons were being turned a great

distance away.

A device was therefor worked out in which an electric globe is used to make the test. When a cylinder has been bored to the correct size it is slid over an electric globe. A piston guage of the exact size of a piston head is then slid into the cylinder and the tester ex-amines it carefully to ascertain it any light leaks around the guage If there is no sign of light it means that the cylinder has been bored properly, but if light shows, the cylinder is rejected as defective.
