
Sent Wrong Cat.

ANTWERP; March 6 .- The bureau of universal statistics announced its 1912 figures today. Among the revolations were the following:

Asia's population is 993,000,000; Europe's 484,000,000; Africa's 188,-000,000; America's 187,000,000, and Oceanica's 57,000,000, a total of 1,-849,000,000 for the world, or a gain of 140,000,000 in four years.

The world's commrce is handled in 47,714 steamships and 55,802 sailing vessels and amounts to \$40,-600,000,000. There are 625,000 miles of railroad's,

The world's national debts total \$42,960,000,000.
