ENTIRE BUSINESS SECTION OF BANDON DESTROYED BY FIRE

**Blaze Started from Defective Flue in
L. N. E. Restaurant at 4:15
this Morning—Buildings
Dynamited**

BANDON, June 11.—A fire that started from a defective flue in the L. N. E. Restaurant at 4:15 this morning has already destroyed two blocks in the heart of the city and is still burning. Among the buildings burned are the following:

L. N. E. Restaurant.

Hartman building, occupied by Averill's Dry Goods Store.

Bandon Drug Co.

Club Saloon, Joe Coach's place.

McNair building, Hardware.

Laird-Lowe building.

Rasmussen Bros.' Eldorado Saloon.

Reskay's Meat Market.

City Market, George Erdman, Proprietor.

Water Company's office.

Bandon Hardware Company.

Gallier residence.

'Art Jamieson's Arcade Saloon and Gross Bros.' Opera Saloon were blown up with dynamite in an effort to stop the flames, but the fire crossed the gap and is still burning Eastward.

The total loss is estimated at 6:30 o'clock to be over \$200,000.

BANDON, 7:30 A. M.—The fire is still burning, but is now thought to be under control.

A strong north wind prevailed, blowing flames across street and saving the Hub Clothing Co. and Golden Rule Dry Goods Store, two business establishments owned by Marshfield people.
