MAKE COUNTY BUDGET

County Commissioners and Judge Meet Today—Budget May Exceed \$700,000.

To make out the budget of all county expenses for the ensuing year a meeting of the commissioners and the county judge will be held today in Coquille. As to what the amount will be that must be expended this year by the county Judge Hall declared he did not know but referred back to the one of last year hoping that "it will not be larger."

Under this head will come all road funds, salaries, money paid into support state institutions and in fact every cent in any way paid out by the county during the year. There are no new projects of moment on hand to necessarily increase this year's budget.

NORTH BEND SUPPLY PIPE LINE SOON

Manager Corey of the Coos Bay Water Company made the following announcement: "The ten inch water main through Perham Park and Ferndale leading north from 10th and Central over the street now being graded will be started within a week or ten days. Work will begin on trenching in Ferndale on the improved streets and on 10th St. north from Central across the backwater above the dredge fill in Perham Park. The later portion across the water will require that the pipe be placed on a trestle above the high water line. This work will be difficult to handle as the posts supporting the pipe must be placed in a substantial manner. Pipe work on the middle portion of 10th St. where grading is now being done will have to wait until the street is planked so that the pipe can be hauled in to the point where it will be used.

This main will give a direct main to North Bend without the water passing through the system in the business section of Marshfield. It will give a complete circuit around the Nob Hill section of town.

E. C. Drews Leaves Telephone Company After Two and One Half Years Service.

After two and one half years with the Coos and Curry Telephone Company E. C. Drews, general manager, has sent in his resignation to take effect on December 1. He is not certain as yet whether or not he will leave Coos Bay.

Mr. Hall, who recently bought out this telephone concern, will return from Hood River with his family the end of this week and it is expected that he will later take over the duties of general manager. He has appointed James E. Montgomery, of Hood River, as Commercial Superintendent. Mr. Montgomery was formerly a newspaper man at Hood River.
