The following days shall be and are thereby declared legal holidays in this state, viz: Every Sunday, the first day of January, the twelfth day of February, the twenty-second day of February, the thirtieth day of May, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the twelfth day of October, the twenty-fifth day of December, and every day on which an election is held throughout the state. and every day appointed by the President of the United States or by the Governor."
