ROAD NECESSITIES POLISH UP THE CITY

TYPES OF MATERIALS AND CONSTRUCTION EXPLAINED

A. B. Gidley Has Interesting Paper on Construction of Roads Before Fellowship Club

Increase of motor driven vehicles on county roads has completely revolutionized the system of road building and has made a long stride toward better highways, according to a paper read Tuesday night by A. B. Gidley before the Fellowship Club on "The Construction of Permanent Roads."

The result has been a change, too, in the methods and the materials used in roads. The laying out of highways is now a matter of greater importance than formerly, more care is taken with the grades and in the matter of curves.

Increase in grades means an increase in power required for hauling. Figures produced are interesting. A pull of 100 pounds is necessary to pull a ton on a level dirt road; on an asphalt surface but 50 pounds. An additional 20 pounds is necessary for each additional per cent of grade.

The greatest load over any road must be governed by the maximum grade in that road.

Types of Drainage. There are three types of drainage to look after in building, namely, underground, lateral and the carrying off of water falling upon the surface of the road.

By side ditches the latter type of drainage can be accomplished. With the proper preparation the engineer believes there is no reason why the clay soils of Coos County should not make first-class foundations for permanent roads.

Planning is not to be considered for a permanent roadway. Never at the most, will it last over six years, often but two. The water runs in between the cracks and together with the working of the planks under traffic soon forms mudholes to spout mud and water and wear the surface.

"If we take four years as the average life of a plank road we will see that at the end of 10 or 12 years the first cost will have been as much as the hard surface and there will be nothing left. In the case of the hard surface the base would be as good as the day it was put down and the wearing surface not more than half worn out."

"During the period of the 10 or 12 years the cost of maintaining the plank road would have been ten times that of the hard surface and the general public at no time would have had a satisfactory road."

Types of Materials. A concrete base of either cement or bitumen with a harder material for the wearing surface gives the best results. This climate is adapted to asphalt. Tests of beach sands would tell if they are suitable for this class of pavement.

Bituminous rock used in Marshfield pavements has been satisfactory and should be considered. With a hard rock that will stand the wear there are a number of types worthy of consideration. Among these are concrete with a two-inch wearing surface of fine hard aggregate put on before the concrete has taken its initial set thus forming a mono-lithic covering for the subgrade, or bituminous or cement concrete base with a wearing surface of bituminous concrete or some of the patent pavements.

Must Get Good Men. When first-class materials are being considered, said Mr. Gidley, it should be borne in mind that competent road builders can not be hired for \$2.50 a day. It would be a good investment to secure a good engineer.
