Make a fort by the use of a white pasteboard box of convenient size turned upside down and marked into oblongs to represent brick. Color the bricks by the use of a red lead pencil or water colors. Place in the center a flagpole surmounted by a flag. Arrange the soldiers on top of and roundabout the fort. The color scheme may be carried further by the use of white place cards the corners of which are decorated with tiny flags in water col-
