Andy and Wendy had a picnic, and -



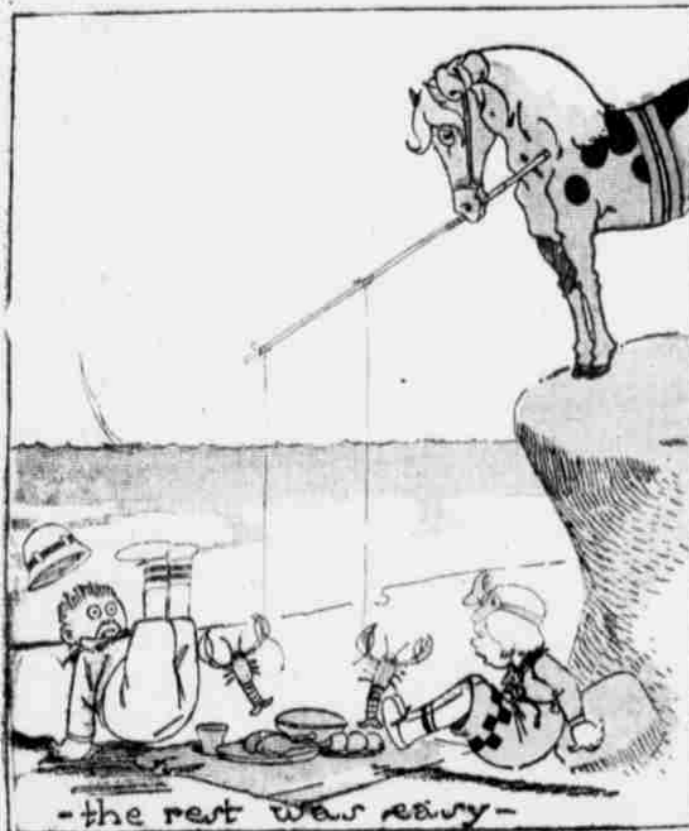
- didn't invite me -



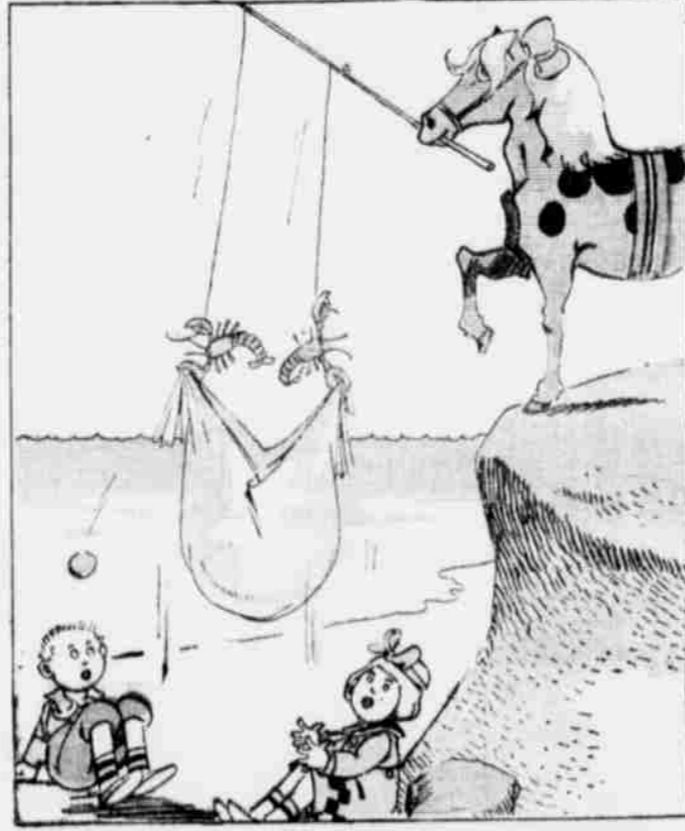
So I went to the man who rents fishing tackle -

- the rest was easy -



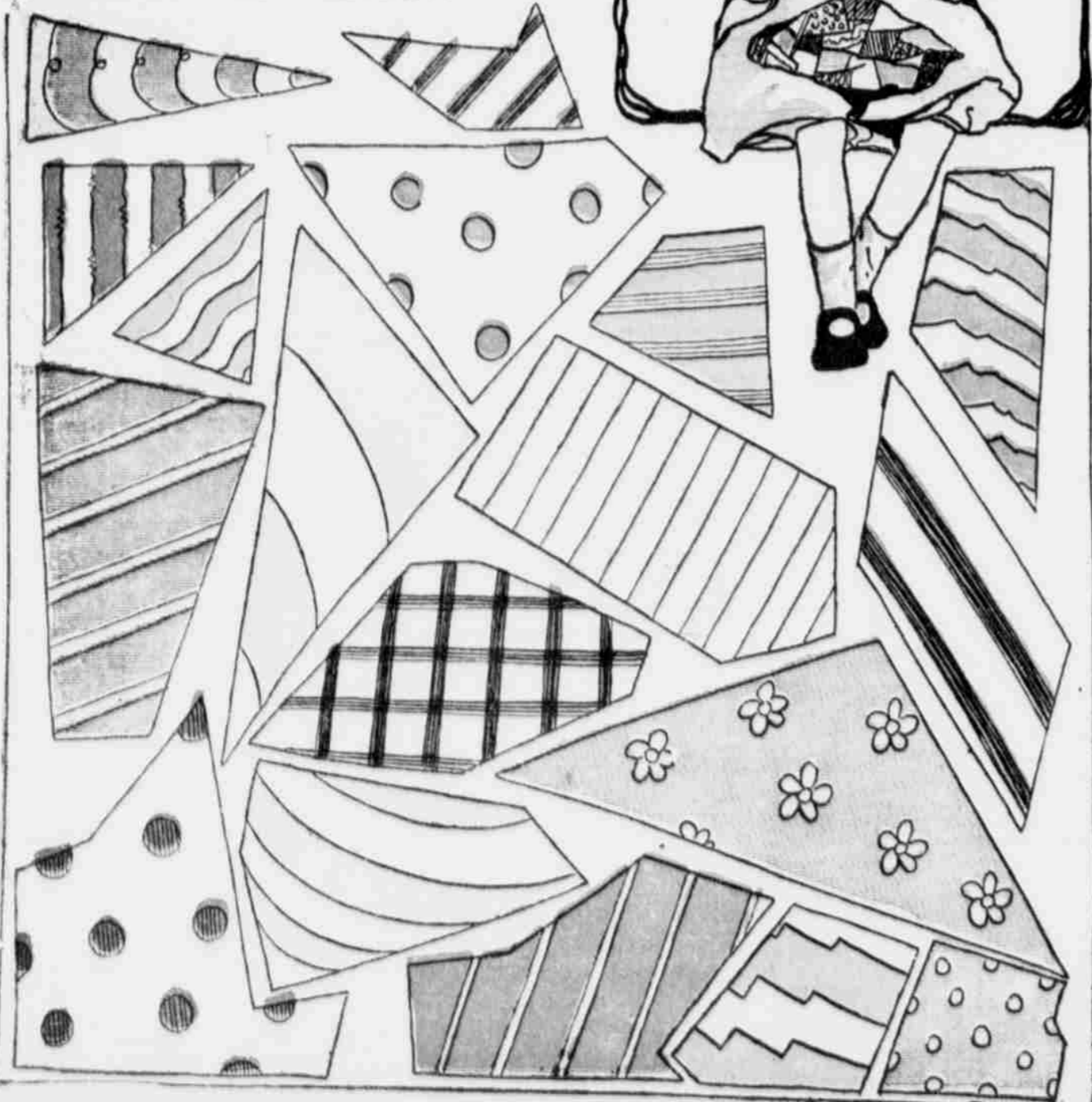
But! I don't see why Andy said I pinched the lunch -
