> The question is one worthy of cor siderable thought before arriving a conclusion.

"Curry is about the only county ; the state where game is still plent ful. It is a big resource if handle properly, as proven by a number c other states, notably Wyoming an Maine. At the present time man\_ hunting parties come here during the summer, buying their license in some other county and many bringing even their ammunition and provisions, and this county derives but little benefit.

## Would Not Be Loss

"If a game reserve was made for 5 or 10 years it would affect our home people but little. Those having homesteads in the reserve could hunt on their own land. In the meantime the deer and scattering bands of elk would increase, and when the time was up, by following the example of some other states. and making the hunter buy a license in this county and hire a guide to go with him into the mountains, the people of Curry county would be deriving the benefit from this resource that they are entitled to.

"Think the matter over. It is a question that can be looked at from more than one angle.
