HOW DID THIS LION TRAINER ESCAPE?

TO FIND OUT YOU MUST FIRST CUT OUT THE CIRCLE CONTAINING THE TRAINER'S HEAD AND STARTING AT THE LOWER LION TRY TO MOVE IT TO THE SPACE MARKED "ESCAPE" YOU MAY CROSS THE CIRCULAR LINES BUT NOT THE SHARP BLACK POINTS WHICH REPRESENT THE CLAWS OF THE LION—BE SURE AND CUT OUT THE CIRCLE EXACTLY AS THIS IS THE POINT THAT REQUIRES THE MOST CARE IN SOLVING THIS DANDY PUZZLE
