

SHOULD THE CZAR DIE NOW.

This Young Man of 20 Would Become Ruler of Russia.

In Russia, according to custom, succession to the throne is along the male line only. If the reigning Czar dies without a son, the crown goes to his next of kin—the elder brother first, then his male descendants, and next in order the other brothers and their sons. It is well known Czar Nicholas has three children, but not one of them could claim the throne in the event of his death, all three being girls. This leaves the Czar's brother as heir-apparent. Until recently the sickly Grand Duke George stood next in line of succession. His sudden death left the youngest brother, Grand Duke Michael, in that important place, as George had no children. Michael is a popular young man, of good habits and disposition. He is not yet 21, having been born Dec. 4, 1878.

It should be understood, however, that while Czar Nicholas has proclaimed his brother Michael as heir to the throne, following long established custom, he can at any moment repeal the proclamation. Russia has no constitution. The Czar is an autocrat and his will is law. He can name as heir to the throne whomever he chooses—his eldest daughter, Olga, or even her

Eminent Professor Chosen President of the University of California.

It is generally conceded that in naming Prof. Benjamin Ide Wheeler of Cornell University to be president of the University of California, a wise selection has been made. Prof. Wheeler has been looked upon for several years past as a very promising piece of presidential timber. He has been professor of Greek and comparative philology at Cornell since 1886, and he is now 45 years of age. His position as a classical scholar is thoroughly established, and his current papers on Alexander the Great in the Century Magazine have shown the wider public how broad a grasp he has upon the great movement of the world's political history, and also how entertainingly he can write. Prof. Wheeler is anything but a recluse student of the type that gives a life's devotion to the dative case; and he is widely known in New York for his effectiveness as a campaigner and his unusual aptitude for practical politics.

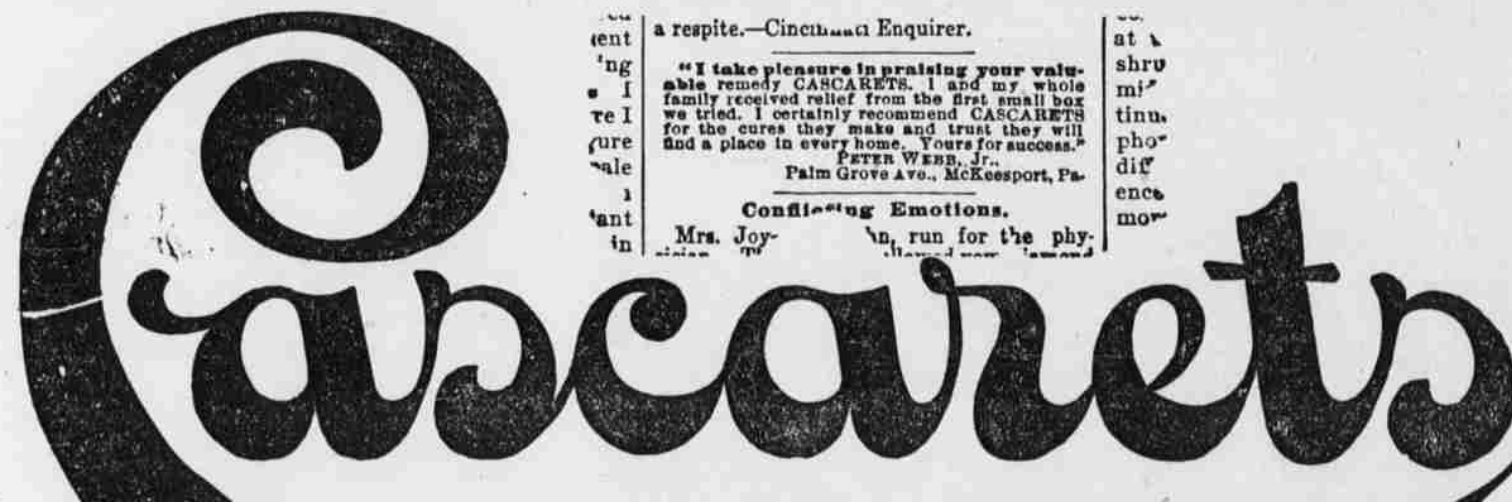
