The United States has available for military duty, but unorganized, 10,343,150 men, in addition to an organized force of 106,339. We trust the powers will make a note of this and be good.

The pistol factory of Hopkins & Allen at Norwich, Conn., was totally destroyed by fire Sunday morning. This removes a strong competitor, and it will now cost Kentuckians a little more to appear in full dress.

Just at present it seems possible for France and England to lock horns, France has been waiting for an opportunity for a great many years and may now figure that England's mixup with the Boers makes the time ripe.

It seems probable that the present congress will authorize the construction of the Nicaragua canal, but the citizens of a large portion of Oregon know that a rose-tinted prospect may quickly receive a daub of fast black at the hands of congress. The time for shouting has not yet arrived.

The last reports from South Africa indicate that there is "lovely fighting along the whole line," with the British troops apparently having a shade the better of it. The British greatly outnumber the Boers and must eventually win. The cost will be heavy, but England never did stop to figure.

Oom Paul's commanding officers at the front are becoming very Aguinaldo. The following message was made public in Boerdom a few days ago: "Lord Roberts is a prisoner; General Buller has been killed; nine thousand British have been killed and seven thousand captured." The Boers will surely meet with a reverse if they don't quit such murderous lying.

William Goebel, the democratic governor of Kentucky, died of his wound, and Taylor, the republican governor, is still doing business, although ignored by the democrats. The outcome is uncertain. While Taylor was probably fairly elected, the death of Goebel has in a measure lost him the sympathy of law-abiding citizens, although he was in no way responsible for the assassination. Goebel was probably the victim of his own dishonesty—but of such is the kingdom of Kentucky.
