1 OIL in Califonnia.
A well-known oil expert has the fol-
lowing to say abont the California ol
industry: The oil production of Calitiornia is
now about $4,500,000$ ba rels annally now about $4,500,000$ barrels annaally.
This output is being increased very
materially each bont materially each month by the product
of the new wells drilled to oil in the
diferent dietrict different districts.
The quetion most frequently asked
me, especially by capitalistes and thove me, especially by capitalists and thowe
interested or likely to be interested in
oil investments is: "Is there not a oil investments is: "'Is there not a
possibility of overproduetion of oil in
California?" There are two main belts extendiug
through the state, located on the eastern and western shores of ancient, pre-
historic eeas. One of these produces a historic reas. One of these prodnces a
black and essentially fuel oil, and the other a green or gas oil. The black or heary oil makes an
ideal fuel, as has been proven by
vears of experience in Russaa and in vears of expe
this country
In using oil as a fuel it is necessary
to exercise considerable jutgment, and to know what kind of oil as
what kind of a burner to use. The two oils, the black and the
green, lie almost in two parallel belts in California extending on the west
side of the San Joagnin valley and running north and south into northern aud sonthern California. There is likewise
a similar condition on the east side ot a similar condition on the cast ride o
the San Joaquin more or less in evi dence as is shown by the outcroppings
and geological formation. The east ide of the valley, however, has not vet side, where developments have already
