total indebtedness of Lincoln county at the beginning of the present month was \$53,396.63, with resources of \$16,-325. Perhaps \$2000 of these resources will go to pay interest on outstanding warrants, making the actual indebtedness \$39,071.63-instead of \$60,000 or \$70,000, as has been unblushingly circulated by the Yaquina Bay Knocker and other dishonest calamity howlers. The semi-annual statement last November showed a total indebtedness of \$52,340.89, with resources of \$6,860.81an actual indebtedness of \$45,480.08or \$8,408.45 more than the present debt. Let it be remembered that these resources are gilt-edged-no inflation. As stated in the report, \$11,325 of the amount is cash. The property bid in by the county at tax sales is not even estimated as a part of the resources, although all are agreed that it amounts to something. This is certainly a good showing, and should in a measure quiet the fears of our citizens who have been taught to believe the county debt is piling up every day.
