Indian Has Right to Drink.

The Supreme Court of the United States, in an opinion by Justice Brewer, Monday, granted the petition of Albert Heff of Kansas for a writ of habeas corpus.

We are of the opinion that, when the United States grants the privileges of citizenship to an Indian, giving him the benefit of and requiring him to be subject to the laws, both civil and criminal, of the state, it places him outside the reach of police regulations on the part of Congress; that the emancipation from Federal control thus created cannot be set aside at the instance of the Government without the consent of the individual Indian and the state, and that the emancipation from Federal control is not affected by the fact that the lands it has granted to the Indian are granted subject to a condition against alienation and incumbrance, or the fact that it guarantees to him an interest in tribal or other property.

This decision apparently applies to the Indians of the Siletz reservation and all other Indians holding land in severalty. In due time a decision is expected declaring such land subject to taxation—the same as that of any other citizen.

Warning.

Complaint having been made that certain persons in Lincoln county, Oregon, are digging into Indian graves and removing the remains of deceased Indians therefrom and also removing certain articles therefrom, I desire to state for the benefit of such persons that a severe penalty is attached to such an offense as is shown by section 1940, Bellinger & Cotton's Annotated Laws of Oregon, which reads as follows, to-wit:

If any person shall willfully and wrongfully dig up, disinter, remove or convey away any human body, or the remains thereof, such person, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary not less than six months nor more than two years, or by imprisonment in the county jail not less than three months nor more than one year.

I trust the above will be sufficient warning and that there will be no more desecration of Indian graves, which should be held just as sacred as the graves of other people.
