Petition for Dyking District.

In the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Lincoln County.
To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners, for Lincoln County, Oregon:
We, your petitioners, whose names are hereinafter affixed, being desirous of forming a dyking district in Lincoln County, Oregon, and embracing the tide lands abutting on Olalla slough and its tributaries in said county and state, respectfully represent and show to this Hon. Court and Board:
That the hereinafter signers are and represent more than one-half of the property owners within said proposed dyking district. We would respectfully show and represent that the hereinafter described lands to be included within said proposed dyking district are subject to overflow by tidewater, and that it is desired to form a dyking district for improving by dyking the lands contained therein; that we, the hereinafter signers, are the owners of one-half or more of the acreage to be embraced in said proposed dyking district; that the lands to be embraced within said proposed dyking district are described by legal subdivisions and by metes and bounds, together with the name of the owner, so far as your petitioners have been able to find, as follows:
