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That Idle Money.

Last week's Reporter contained in an editorial a few comments on the evil of idle money with special reference to Lincoln county's finances.

Were this a true statement of affairs it would be deserving of the severest criticism. The needless expenditure of money in interest or otherwise is to be at all times deplored.

It is presumed that all understand that the county, not having money to pay its running expenses, issues warrants which draw 6 per cent interest from the date of their endorsement by the county treasurer till the DATE THEY ARE CALLED.

When sufficient money accumulates in the county general fund the warrants are called in and the warrants included in the call are paid when presented. No WARRANT DRAWS INTEREST AFTER IT IS CALLED.

The last call was made the 5th day of Sept. 1907, and included all warrants endorsed prior to and on the 8th day of December, 1905. The interest on all warrants endorsed prior to that date was thereby stopped.

How about those resolutions? Have you kept any of them?
