**WRECK ON THE C. & E.**

**Two Freight Cars are Demolished but no One is Injured.**

Last Friday C. & E. Train No. 16 was wrecked about one mile above Pioneer at 1 p. m. The wreck occurred at bridge 23 and was caused by a loose wheel on the hind truck of the forward car. The wheel dropped down on the inside of the rail causing the truck to turn crossways and drop between the ties of the bridge, stopping the train almost instantly and causing two freight cars loaded with wood to fall about thirty feet into the gulch smashing them into kindlingwood. Had the train been going at its usual speed several more cars would have met the same fate, but owing to just having come out of the tunnel the train was going at a very slow speed. Only one set of trucks went off the bridge, the five remaining trucks being all twisted and smashed under the third car. Had bridge 23 not been a very solid and strong bridge it would have collapsed, thereby making the wreck much worse. The bridge crew arrived about 5 p. m. and had the wreck removed and the track repaired, allowing the trains to proceed on their way about 9 p. m.

There was no grumbling among the waiting passengers as most of them were felling very thankful over the narrow escape, from death or injury, that they had experienced and were glad to think they were able to wait.
