FIR \& SPRUCE MILL TO START.

After Three Years of Idlenes the big Sawmill at Toledo will Begin Sawing

Last Tuesday evening Lewis Montgomery, of the firm of Mann * Montgomery, with headquarters at Portland, owners of the Fir \& Spruce Lumber Company's holdings
at this place, arrived, accompanied by several men, engineer, cruisers, cte., and the following morning began preparations for starting the big sawmill here. The mill is being repaired and the machinery adjusted, which work will take a couple of weeks, then sawing will be commenced.
Mr. Montgomery says it is their intention to operate the mill steadily. They will not attempt to run the mill to its full capacity, but will be content to cut in the neighborhood of thirty thousand daily, requiring twenty or thirty men in the mill. The logging camps will start immediately, thus requiring many more men.
The company has a million and a half feet of logs in the water in booms and aboui that many feet cut in the woods, but they will begin cutting more as soon as things can be put in working order.

An Important Meeting.
A meeting of the citizens of Lincoln county has been called to meet at the City Hall here this evening. This is an important meeting and should be attended by every citizen. The object of this meeting is to take some action looking to the tredging of the river from Elk City
to deep water on the lower river.

mportance to the entire Bay country mportance to the entire Bay country and all Lincoln county. It is absolutely necessary that the river be
improved so that coasting vessels be enabled to get up to Toledo and Elk City to carry out the output of the mills and other products of the country. Unless this be done we cannot progress; our commerce will still continue to be strangled.
Our representative in Congress iafluence to have a bill appropriating money for this work passed but does not seem greatly encouraged. c.suraged.

The fact of the matter is we have got a situation to meet that every Waterway in Oregon, outside of the Colmmina, is up against. The attitude of the Government, through its engineers, is dead against us, and to our mind, no help can be
expected from the government with expcted from the government within time to do us any good. WG have got to help ourselves, and to
depend upon ourselves alone depend upon ourselves alone. Fortunately there is a way open to do this. We can follow in the footstepe of Coos Bay, Sfuslaw, Tills snook and Nehalem and form a port of our own and make our own improvements. It is vital that we do this, and action in that direction should be taken at once.
