Lincoln County Transportation Co.

Company Incorporated to Operate Vessels Between Yaquina, Alsea, Siuslaw and Portland.

Captain George Tyler has filed with the County Clerk articles of incorporation of the Lincoln County Transportation Company, and is now disposing of stock in the new company. The object of this company is to operate freight vessels between this, Alsea, Siuslaw and Columbia river ports, with principal offices at Toledo. The company is incorporated with a capital stock of \$20,000, and will sell shares at \$1.00 each. The incorporators are George Tyler, of Newport, A. H. Hill and F. C. Savage of Portland. Capt. Tyler will be captain of the vessel and manager of the company. The company has promised the Siuslaw people a ten-day schedule during Summer months, and Yaquina Bay a regular weekly service—that is the boat will make scheduled trips from Portland to all points on this Bay as far as Toledo once a week, during the Summer months and will run as near the schedule in Winter months as the weather and the bars will permit.

The company has an option on the power schooner *Wilhelmina*, 140 tons, 85 feet long, 20 foot beam, drawing 7½ feet loaded, depth of hold 6 feet 6 inches. The vessel is equipped with heavy gear capable of lifting seven tons. She is a twin screw, 150 horsepower, also carries sails. This boat was built about a year ago at a cost of \$22,000. The company has an option to purchase the vessel at a much smaller figure, and there is no doubt but that the necessary stock will be sold to buy her. It is the intention of the company to make the enterprise principally a Lincoln county enterprise, and will sell most of the stock in this county. That the enterprise will be successful there is no doubt, as the business men and all citizens of this Bay and both Alsea and Siuslaw are subscribing for stock and pledging material support in the way of business. The captain informs us that he has already been offered several loads of freight. Captain Tyler, who is to manage the company's business is one of the best known masters on the coast having been in the transportation business for the past thirty-five years and has operated vessels on the coast for over thirty years, consequently is familiar with all the details of the business and can and will give the people and the company better service than could probably any other man, as he is acquainted with every condition.

It is up to the people to see that the vessel is bought and put on the run. It will mean thousands of dollars a year saved in freight rates. This alone would repay for the money spent even if the company should never pay a dividend, and there is no reason to believe that the company will not pay dividends. If each individual cannot take a hundred or a thousand shares take one, and help this enterprise and thereby help themselves.
