Notice to Voters

All voters registered for the general election of two years ago, and who are residing within the limits of the proposed Ports to be voted on at the Special election May 5th, 1910, are entitled to vote at said special election. And all voters residing within the limits of said proposed ports, who were not registered two years ago, but who are legal voters may vote at such election by use of Blank A and the aid of six free holders. All foreign born citizens who made Declaration of Intention one year prior to May 5th 1910, or who are naturalized, but were not registered for the general election of two years ago, should bring their papers with them on election day in order to assist the officer swearing them in with Blank A. No person however who is not a resident within the limits of the proposed Port shall be entitled to vote.

Vote for the Ports.

Prepare for the coming fair.

If ports are not a good thing why do other bays and rivers create them?

At the meeting of the Development League Wednesday evening it was voted to hold a county fair again this Fall. Farmers, it is now up to you to raise those big pumpkins, calves, etc. Beat your last year exhibit.

Create the Port and vote bonds to dredge the upper river of these little bars, then it will be just as easy for vessels drawing ten or twelve feet of water to come to Toledo as it is for the schooner Wilhelmina now.

The precincts voting on the Ports at the election next Thursday are Alsea, Beaver Creek, Elk City, Five Rivers, Newport, Toledo, Tidewater and Yaquina. People living in Newport and Yaquina precincts will vote on the Newport proposition; Toledo Port will be composed of parts of Toledo, Newport, Yaquina, Elk City and Beaver Creek precincts; Alsea Port district is composed of parts of Alsea, Five Rivers, Tidewater and Beaver Creek precincts. Come out to this election and show by your vote that you believe in improvement of your locality. If you registered for the last general election you will not be required to register at this election.

As the work of taking the census of Toledo was nearing its close last week we had a talk with the enumerator of this district and in the course of our conversation it developed that from the way things looked at that time there should be in the neighborhood of five and a half hundred persons numbered as residents of Toledo City proper when the government finally makes its report. This figure has to do with people making their place of abode strictly within the incorporated limits of the city. It does not include those living in the several clusters of houses in the suburbs such as near Altree's mill and along Depot and Olalla Sloughs, so that in the aggregate, counting those who
