AN INTERESTING FIND.

Medal with Effigy of Joan of Arc Unearthed by French Farmer.
In the course of pulling down some outhouses by a farmer of Espaly, Saint Marcel, in the demesne of the castle the bishops of Puy had built in the fourteenth century, and which was destroyed by the royalist troops in the religious wars, there has just been discovered a lead coin or medal, between the size of a 5-franc and a 2-franc piece, bearing the effigy of Joan of Arc. On the front of the medal is the figure of the shepherdess of Domremy on her knees, with her flock, and listening to the warnings of St. Michael, who appears in rays of light, under the guise of a winged warrior, the lance in his left hand. On the reverse side is the Pucelle on horseback, ready for battle, with helmet and breastplate, flying banner and brandishing her victorious sword, while her charger is represented in galloping attitude. The medal bears the legend "Jeanne d'Arc, 1409-1431."
This commemorative coin appears to have been struck at the beginning of the seventeenth century. How has it been found in a building of the feudal times? That is a point, says a Paris contemporary, difficult to explain, as is also the date of 1409 instead of 1412. However that may be, the find is interesting and will give pleasure, adds our contemporary, to the historians of the national heroine. No doubt the find is interesting, as is everything in France just now connected with the maid. Many suggestions offer themselves for the coin's being in the place where found. It might have been lost by trippers or children and forced underground by rain, and as to the mistake in the date, it might be due to ignorance on the designer's part, or Joan might have heard the voices some time before the year 1412.

FAREWELL IN MANY TONGUES.

Demonstration Is Made When the "Queen's Own" Left Tientsin.
Every great army in the world has its representatives in China. But Tientsin, being the leading place on the road to Peking, has more variety than any other oriental city.
To bid farewell to the Second Battalion of the Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders, on their transference to India, a remarkable gathering has just been held here, a Tientsin correspondent of the Detroit Free Press says.
These are the men who guard the legations and stand ever on watch against a recurrence of Boxer outbreaks that would endanger the lives of diplomatic, consular, commercial or missionary foreigners.
At this farewell meeting Brigadier General W. H. H. Waters presided, supported on his left by Captain and Adjutant W. H. McCowan, and on his right by Major A. F. Douglas-Hamilton of the British army.
Grouped around him were men of the American, German, French, Austrian, Belgian, Italian, Dutch, Russian, Chinese and Japanese armies and navies—all in hearty accord and comradeship, for here in China they stand not as possible opponents, but co-defenders of the peaceful residents against those who work for revolution, pillage and anarchy.
America's representatives were Sergeant Kasser and Sergeant Bell, smart and trim; their plain, neat uniforms contrasting sharply with the more highly colored Scottish tartans and the turbaned warriors of England's Indian native regiments.
It was a remarkable demonstration of the solidarity of the armed forces of civilization, stationed on guard in the flowery land, while the giant hordes of the Chinese nation are straining forward on the path of modern progress.
