BUILDING GOOD ROADS.

Now that the constitution of the state has been amended, allowing counties to bond for road improvements, it may be assumed that interest in better country highways will be greater than ever before in Oregon. Already there is talk of taking advantage of the provisions of the law in Lane county at an early date.

On this subject of road building, the views of Samuel Hill, president of the Washington Good Roads Association, is entitled to consideration. He believes there are few objections to good roads which are not founded upon ignorance of the work being done, and is of the opinion that when the people of the state of Washington as a whole fully understand the question of good roads they will want them simply because they will realize that it is to their personal interest to have them.

There is no question of the truth of Mr. Hill's contention. The road laws of the state are imperfectly understood. Although the state aid road law might be improved by amendment, it is in the main a measure well designed for the improvement of highways of the state. Moreover, it is a measure which particularly works for the establishment of good roads at the minimum expense to the farmer.

"How many people," asks Mr. Hill, "know that state-aid roads, where the county pays half and the state pays half, are built largely at the expense of the municipalities and cities. Out of every \$100 spent on these roads \$51.92 is paid by taxes of those living in towns, yet not one dollar of this sum can be spent within the corporate limits of the city. When the farmers come to understand that this is an actual gift made to them by the people of the city they will to a man, I believe, favor state aid."

The best argument for good roads in fact is to let the people see good roads and use them. It is invariably true that those who are most enthusiastic over good roads are those who, like Mr. Hill, know most about them. Every good road, as a natural consequence, creates its disciples.
