In the matter of the claim of Alvin W. Thorpe affidavit for cancellation of taxes, refused.

Report of Ira Wade, on scalp bounty issued, approved.

Petition of J. Van Schoick, et al, relative to roads, continued.

Bond of G. B. McCluskey, as treasurer, examined and approved.

Bonds of R. H. Howell, as clerk, and Bert Geer, as sheriff, examined and approved.

In the matter of the bids for repairing Elk City bridge, bid of C. E. Van Orden, to repair bridge at \$210, to furnish material as per list filed, and to do all work, accepted.

In case more material is required to be furnished in bridge at \$10 per 1000.

In the matter of petition for extension of survey on Siletz road, continued.

Petition of J. F. Stewart, et al, for appropriation for Lincoln County Fair, granted, and an appropriation of \$250, ordered to apply on present indebtedness as committee may direct.

Petition of John Veason, for rebate of taxes, granted.

Whereas, James H. Ross, Ira Wade, and John Fogarty, formerly Sheriff, Clerk and Commissioner, respectively, of Lincoln County Oregon, retired from office January 1st, 1911, after a number of years each served as such public officials of Lincoln County Oregon, and retired voluntarily, to make way for other deserving citizens respectively to fill such offices, they severally deeming it fitting and proper to have a reasonable degree of rotation in office under our elective system, and

Whereas, each of said officials has maintained a high degree and standard of efficiency in his office, which has rebounded in a large measure to economy in public affairs, to the great convenience and satisfaction of the public generally having business relations with Lincoln County, and reflecting on themselves a high degree of credit for their unflinching devotion to public business and the interests of the taxpayers and community at large, as is also evidenced currently by expressions of commendation and approval in the public press of Lincoln County Oregon, and by many expressions of approval from citizens and taxpayers throughout the county, therefore,

Resolved, that it is the sense of this court, that the thanks of the court, and of the community at large are due to each and every of said retiring officials, and that this court hereby expresses its approval of their public service while in such office.

Resolved, that all supplies ordered by county officials are to be authorized by some member of the County Court.

At this time came on to be heard

the report of J. H. Wilson Attorney at Law and Accountant, heretofore appointed by the court to make an examination of the books and accounts of the County School Superintendent, Clerk, Sheriff and Treasurer, relating to the handling of county funds from November 15th 1907, the date of the report of W. H. Moore, Accountant, to January 1st, 1911, from which it appears to the court that this examination has been made properly, by Mr. Wilson in person, and that his report sets forth in detail the sources from which county funds have been collected, the amounts thereof, and their deposit in the treasury, as well as a total statement, independently obtained from the vouchers and evidence thereof, of the disposition of such funds by the treasurer, and showing a balance in the treasury on January 1st, 1911, of \$15,376.56, all of which money is on deposit in the Lincoln County Bank, Toledo, Oregon, in the name of G. B. McCluskey as Treasurer of Lincoln County, Oregon.

And it appearing to the court that Mr. Wilson has well and faithfully performed this service for Lincoln County, and in careful, professional manner, and to the satisfaction of the county court.

It is therefore ordered by the court that said report be accepted, and placed on file by the county clerk, and that it be copied in full upon the journal of this court.

It is further ordered that said Report be approved in substance and in fact.

In the matter of the report of W. E. Ball, report from timber owners on cruise. Report approved, resolution adopted by vote of Commissioners Kentta and Thompson, Judge Gardner voting "No."
