Because of the fact that Lincoln County has, no doubt, as long a list of non-resident taxpayers as any county in Oregon, in proportion to the tax business transacted, and that there is consequent heavy correspondence business, which requires more time than the personal transactions, the next turnover, to be made at the end of this month, will add quite an appreciable sum to the total collected.
