Tuesday's Oregonian contained a news item from Salem stating that Hon. B. F. Jones of Newport, is a prospective candidate for the office of Secretary of State. The Leader does not know whether Mr. Jones will be a candidate or not, but if he is, then we predict that he will be nominated and elected. There is no better qualified man in Oregon for this important office than Ben Jones. He was County Clerk of Lincoln County for five and one half years, Register of the United States Land Office at Roseburg for four years and has served three terms in the Oregon Legislature. The experience gained in these offices has particularly fitted him for the duties of Secretary of State. Mr. Jones is the author of the Roosevelt Highway measure, and is the secretary of the Roosevelt Highway Association, and has done more than any other man in the state to secure favorable action on this important highway. Dear Mr. Hawley:

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your letter of date September 29th, requesting a list of Indian allottees on the Siletz Reservation, who have been given patents in fee within the last few months.

In response you are advised that no fee patents covering land on the Siletz Reservation have been issued to Indian allottees since July 1, 1919.

You are further advised that a Competency Commission recently visited the Siletz Reservation. Said Commission recommended that patents in fee simple be issued to certain Indian allottees. The report of the Commission has been received and in many of these cases a recommendation has been made that fee patents be issued. The recommendation has been approved by the Department but the fee patents have not been issued by the General Land Office. As soon as the patents are issued they will be delivered promptly.
